### **General Information**

### Rules and regulations

This show is sanctioned by the American Miniature Horse Association. All Exhibitors will abide the 2023 AMHA rule book.

- All horses participating in AMHA classes must be registered with AMHA.
- Copies of BOTH sides of all registration papers must accompany entry forms. Gelding status
  MUST be reflected on registration certificates for horses entered to be show in the AMHA
  classes. If leased horse is entered in the amateur classes, written verification of the lease
  from the AMHA office must accompany the entry form. Pending for a registration number will
  not be accepted by the AMHA.
- No entry fee will be refunded without a veterinarian's certificate verifying the horse's unsoundness to the show.
- Send in copy of stallion Verification report.
- All Amateurs must have a current AMHA amateur card and a copy must be submitted along with entries and copy of AMHA papers. Applications available in show office.
- All youth exhibitors must include AMHA youth number and birthdate on entry form. Youth cards will be available at show office. All youth must have parent/guardian signature on entry form. NO youth under the age of 12 are allowed to show any stallion.
- Any Exhibitor with Special Needs is welcome to participate in all shows.
- Judge's evaluation forms are available in show office. Completion is voluntary.
- · All dogs MUST be kept on a leash at all times dogs are not allowed in hitching or show area.
- Abuse of animals, show personal or exhibitors will not be tolerated at this show. Such behaviour will be grounds for disqualification from the show and no entry fee will be refunded.
- Horses must not me left unattended in the hitching area / wash racks. There will be no tying horses to the arena fence.
- The Saskatchewan Miniature Horse Club or the Moose Jaw Exhibition Co. is not responsible for damages, injury, loss or theft that may occur to a person, animal or article or thing on the premises of the show.
- Show Farrier and Veterinarian emergency numbers will be posted.
- Aisles and passages will be kept clean and clear at all times.
- Box stalls, only 2 horses max per stall.
- No exhibitor is permitted to select his/her own stabling. All stabling will be assigned.
   Wash racks are hot and cold water, your horses will love them.

#### Measuring

Attention: All papers are required by the STEWARD when measuring your horse.

NO papers = Don't measure = Don't show.

Have your paper work on order to help the process go smoothly and quicker.

# Show Fees and General Information ENTRY CLOSING DATE AUGUST 02, 2022

FEE SCHDULE: Entry fee of \$25.00 per class up to four classes(entry fee included under both judges)

Four or more classes \$100 per horse

Youth classes (those specified as youth) are \$10.00 per class

Youth and Special Needs Showmanship, costume, Egg and spoon race, musical chairs and judge's choice are free.

Entry under only one judge is not permitted. ENTRIES MUST BE POST MARKED ON OR BEFORE July 17, 2023.

LATE ENTRIES FOR HORSES NOT ALREADY ENTERED BY JULY 17, 2023 WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL JULY 20, 2023 HOWEVER THE FEE WILL BE \$30 PER CLASS (YOUTH \$15.00 PER CLASS). AND THE ENTRY MAY NOT APPEAR IN THE PROGRAM. Any changes to entries for horses already entered in the show will be accepted by the show manager until 7:30 am of the day of the class. Complete entries include payment of fees. You will not be allowed to show if fees are unpaid.

<u>STABLING:</u> Stalls are 10'x9' = \$25.00 for SMHC members and \$35.00 for non-members per day (Friday evening to Sunday evening). Additional nights stabling (ie: arriving Thurs) may be arranged by contacting Moose Jaw Exhibition Co. at 306-692-2723.

It is permitted and encouraged to stall only two horses together. Tack stalls are priced same as above. Please indicate on entry form if you wish to be stabled with someone. All horses must show out of an assigned stall.

<u>BEDDING:</u> Is available through the show committee to purchase. To purchase these please complete on your entry forms. Bags are \$10.00 per bag and are 3 cubic feet and are to be paid for with your entry fees. You may bring your own shavings.


