FEE SCHEDULE: Entry fee of \$30.00 per class (Entry fee includes entry under all Judges) Youth Classes are \$15.00 per class, except Showmanship & Costume are Free. Entry under one Judge is not permitted. **ENTRY DEADLINE MAY 18, 2025**

Entries for horses not already entered by **MAY 18**, will be accepted until **JUNE 1st**, However the fee will be **\$35.00 per class (\$20 for youth)**, and the entry may not appear in the program.

ALL ENTRY FEES MUST BE TRANSFERRED WITH IN 24 HOURS OF CONFIRMATION FROM SHOW MANAGER. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOW IF FEES ARE UNPAID.

Exhibitor Packages will only be available AFTER your horses have been measured. **A PHOTOCOPY OF BOTH SIDES OF THE REGISTRATION PAPERS MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FOR EACH HORSE** (PLEASE NO FAX PAPERS). Each horse entered must provide proof of vaccinations. (See Rules and Regulations).

STALLING: approx. 10' X 10' = \$70.00 for WCMHC Members and \$80.00 for non-members (Thursday evening to Sunday evening) It is permitted and encouraged to stall two horses together. Three horses per stall is not allowed. Tack Stalls - priced the same as above. Stalls will be assigned as completed entries come in. Committee members will be stalled first. **If you need to be stalled beside another exhibitor all entries must be received at the same time with a note on entry form. No jump out showing permitted. (Showing from a trailer with more than one horse)**

Emergency exits cannot be blocked by carts. If you prefer to lock your cart you may rent a stall for your cart providing we have stalls available.

BEDDING: Stalls are bedded with and initial layer of bulk shavings, any additional shavings will be \$10/Bag. Additional bags are recommend.

POST ENTRIES: Will be accepted up to 5 CLASSES PRIOR TO the post entered class. Regular class fee will increase to \$35.00 per class Youth post entries will increase to \$20.00. Horses must already be entered in the show. Post entries will only be accepted by the Show Manager and only on the official form.

MOVE IN/OUT: Horses may move into stalls Thursday, July 25, any time **after 2pm**. Stalls will be assigned. Exhibitors are required to stay where assigned, do not move your stalls or other exhibitors. All stalls must be vacated Sunday evening, and it is requested that horses and exhibitors remain until the close of the show. **Out of province exhibitors** can make arrangements for extra nights depending on the facility. MEASURING: Will Start approx.. 6 pm. Thursday, June 19. All extra fees must be paid before your horse will be measured. All exhibitors MUST have copies of their horse's registration papers, and a completed measuring card with them at time of measuring. ALL AMHR horses will be measured BEFORE any AMHA horses are measured. **ALL MEASURING WILL HAPPEN THURSDAY, FRIDAY OR SATURDAY NIGHT. THERE WILL BE NO MORNING MEASURING BEFORE THE SHOW STARTS. HARDSHIP MEASURING WILL BE DONE AT END OF SHOW ON FRIDAY.**

ETRANSFER; All entry fees will be E transferred, Payments for post entries and show related costed incurred at the show will be paid at the show office using WCMHC square. E-transfer to wcmhctreas@gmail.com

AWARDS: Ribbons to sixth place under each Judge (2 sets) - Halter Classes, Ribbons to ALL Jr. & Sr. Champions and Reserve and Grand and Reserve Champions. Champion and Reserve Ribbons for, Driving Stake Classes, Ribbons to sixth place – Hi Point for Open Hunter, Open Halter Obstacle, Open Jumper, Open Driving Obstacle and Versatility. To be awarded during the Finale show, after combining points from both shows.

EXHIBITORS, MUST SIGN A WAIVER, IF YOU ARE NOT LISTED ON ENTRY FORMS AS AN EXHIBITOR. A SEPARATE WAIVER IS AVAILBALE AT THE SHOW OFFICE. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE RING.

NO REFUND FOR ANY ENTRY FEES WITHOUT A LETTER FROM A VETERNARIAN STATING WHY YOUR ANIMAL CAN NOT ATTEND THE SHOW.

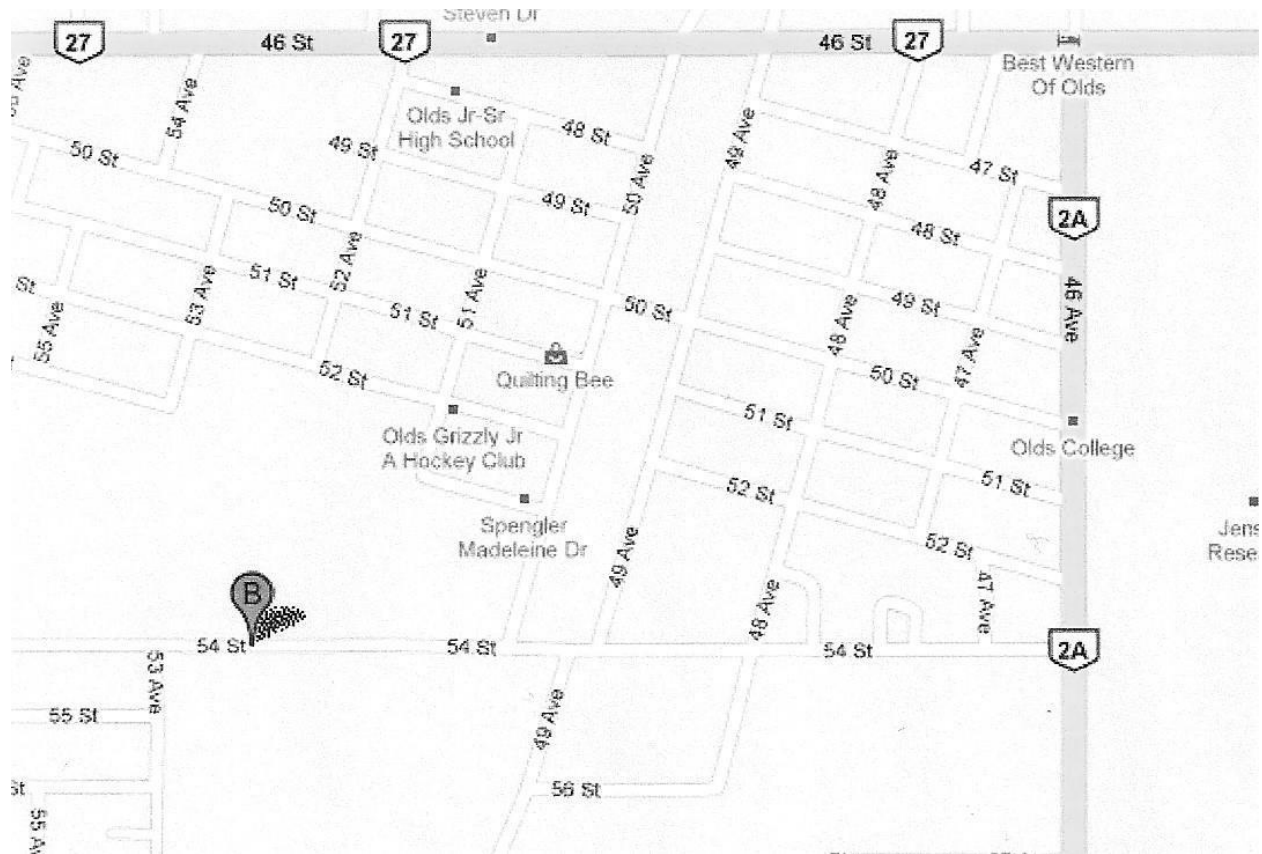
POST ENTRY: Defined as entering a class not previously entered. At the time of sending in entries all classes should be listed, the fee will be 5.00 more than the original class cost.

MEASURING SHEET: If at measuring your horse's height changes from what you entered, you will receive a sheet to change classes to the appropriate height division. Changes will be made at no extra cost to exhibitor. NO REFUND for horses measuring out of the show, see committee for substitutions.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Replacing a horse for another in the SAME class/ division/ halter or performance will be allowed at no extra charge.

SCRATCH: Any horse can be scratched from any class there will be NO REFUND for scratches. If your horse is scratched because of injury or lameness, see committee for substitutions.

GRADE MINIATURE HORSE CLASSES: Non rated (no points, not affiliated with any registry) Grade Miniature Horse classes open to all unregistered horses as a way to promote our small equine. Horses will still be measured as requirements state 38" and under. Measuring will take place after measuring for the registered horses. Classes will run with the rules and standards of each registry in order for the attendee's to get to understand how each registry works. Classes must still be entered and vaccines requirements are in effect as they are WCMHC Rules. Non members are required to follow the policies set here in this premium. Stalls are required if staying overnight.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- l. This show is sanctioned by the American Miniature Horse Association. All exhibitors must abide by the 2024 AMHA Rule Book. **ALL HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH AMHA.**
2. Copies of BOTH sides of all registration papers must accompany entry forms. Gelding status must be reflected on registration certificates for horses to be shown. Senior Stallions must have a Stallion Verification report. Proof of vaccination for equine influenza and equine viral Rhinopneumonitis, in the form of a vet bill or vaccination receipts, must accompany the entry form. If a leased horse is entered in the amateur classes, written verification of the lease from the AMHR office must accompany entry form. Pending for a registration number will not be accepted. **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED TO SENDER.**
3. No entry fees will be refunded without a veterinarian's certificate verifying unsoundness to show
4. All YOUTH AND AMATEURS must have a current AMHA card and a copy must be submitted with entry form. Applications are available at the show.
5. **It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to barn areas are a management courtesy - not mandatory.**
10. HORSES MUST NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN THE HITCHING RING/ WASH RACKS. Do not tie horses to the Arena rail – *Failure to follow this rule may result in the exhibitor being asked to leave the grounds.*
- ll. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Dogs are not allowed to stay in the hitching area. **DO NOT TIE YOUR DOGS SO THE CAN CROSS THE ALLEY WAY. IF YOU ARE NOT AT YOUR STALLS DO NOT LEAVE YOUR DOG TIED TO THE STALLS.**
- l2. Abuse of animals, show personnel or exhibitors will not be tolerated at this show such behavior will be grounds for immediate disqualification. No fees will be refunded. REVIEW DETAILS BELOW**
13. All Youth using the Arena during down time **MUST** wear a helmet when driving.
12. A \$25.00 facility fee will be applied to horses staying in the barn for hard shipping with show horses but not registered in the show. The \$25.00 fee does not apply to Futurity Horses. Proof of vaccination is **REQUIRED** for these horses as well.
13. The Show Committee reserved the right to limit the number of tack stalls to 1 per farm/exhibitor.

WCMHC Policy on Sick Horses at Shows

In order for this policy to take effect, the show manager must receive at least three complaints from three separate exhibitors, each accompanied by a \$50 deposit, regarding the health of a horse present at the show.

If these complaints are received, representatives of the show committee must inform the owner of the horse in question that these complaints have been received, and a vet of the show committee's choice must be called to examine the horse. The exam will take place without the interference of the owner of the horse. If it is determined that the horse is sick and/or contagious, then the bill for the vet will be paid for by the owner of the horse, and the deposits made by the complainants will be refunded. If it is determined that the horse is not sick or contagious, the deposits made by the complainants will be used to pay the bill for the vet. It will be up to the show committee in consultation with the vet to determine whether the horse will remain at the show, will remain at the show but be isolated from the other horses, or will be asked to leave.

If a sick horse is already under veterinary medical care, it may attend the show if it is not contagious and the owner can produce a statement from his or her veterinarian confirming the non-contagious state of the horse.

12. MISCONDUCT.

Conduct by an exhibitor, trainer, owner or immediate family member of an unsportsmanlike, abusive or detrimental nature will not be tolerated by show management. Including but not limited to threatening, abusive, or intimidating conduct physical, written or verbal toward any individual or show official.

Any persons guilty of such conduct should be reported to the show manager immediately. Show management will investigate the accusation and act accordingly. Show Management can/will suspend the offender(s) for the duration of the WCMHC Show Weekend receiving no refund of any kind.

Accused may appeal the show management decision to the Board of Directors at the WCMHC AGM. If found guilty of such behavior and the show management acted appropriately the accused may be barred from WCMHC sponsored shows. If the decision is reversed the BOD may decide to refund the CLASS ENTRIES.
